The Office of Special Events and Filming, Department of City Manager, works hard to ensure the majority of Long Beach property owners and businesses are aware and have approved filming within their area. Special Events and Filming staff require production companies to obtain signature approval from any property owners and/or property managers or business affected by no parking, lighting, and/or sound caused by the filming.

Production companies are given the following policy regarding signatures:

City of Long Beach Good Neighbor Policies

Welcome to the neighborhood! The following policies have been developed to ensure a safe and peaceful experience for all involved.

Permit Notification

All affected property owners and businesses must be notified **(through the City of Long Beach Office of Special Events and Filming approved signature process)** prior to filming or production set preparation. No permits should be assumed issued without the film office review and approval.

Days and Hours

Production permits may be issued Sunday through Saturday between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. with 66.6% approval of all impacted property owners and/or property managers. Production permits may be issued Sunday through Saturday between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. with 80% approval of impacted property owners and/or property managers. *Impacted property owners and/or businesses are defined as anyone on the immediate block being filmed. Those property owners and/or businesses affected by the posting of no parking, lighting and/or sound as it relates to film activity may also require signatures.*

Signatures

Location Managers, Location Agents, and/or Permit Services shall collect signatures of all impacted property owners, property managers, and/or businesses.

Parking and Other Restrictions

A parking plan shall be submitted along with the application. The City of Long Beach Film Office must approve all parking plans. Parking should not be assumed available without written permission from the City of Long Beach Film Office. Parking and equipment placement is not permitted without proper signature approvals being obtained through the City of Long Beach signature process (see above). Written permission must be submitted to the City of Long Beach Film Office for prior approval. Street closures and Intermittent Traffic Control and/or Pedestrian Control must be permitted through the City of Long Beach Film Office and shall be done with proper safety personnel on site. No-parking signs may not be nailed to trees on city parkways or on private property.

The City of Long Beach Film Office may apply restrictions to noise and lighting relating to production as it impacts other neighbors.

Base Camp and Catering

The City of Long Beach Film Office must approve all base camp and catering areas prior to set-up.
